## 6.6.1.p.a.2.Lp. Augusta Technical College Procedure Return of Military Tuition Assistance

Any student may drop a course without financial obligation within the allowable refund period (1<sup>st</sup> 3 days of the semester). During this time, 100% of Tuition Assistance (TA) funds will be returned to the Department of Defense. If a military student receiving TA funds from the Department of Defense withdraws after the allowable refund period; Augusta Technical College will return unearned TA funds to the government on a proportional basis through the 60% portion of the period for which the TA funds were provided. Augusta Technical College will return any unearned TA funds directly to the military service, not to the service member. When the military student stops attending for military service obligation, Augusta Technical College will work toward solutions that avoid student debt for the returned portion of TA funds.
